Why you should use tags + bookmarks?

- ◆ Build a smart global collection of shareable web links (URLs):
 - ◆ Smart: You provide context (tagging)
 - ◆ Global: it's stored on a web server - access from any browser
 - ◆ Shareable: grant access to your community (peers)
- ◆ Connect to peers (our HCI community?)
- ◆ Search within global, community, private context
- ◆ Example: Organize your research-related links (papers, people, conferences)

Tags / tagging

- ◆ Tag: one-word concept, keyword
- ◆ Ex.: mac, HCI, conferences, interaction
- ◆ Ideally: Same meaning for everybody (!?)
- ◆ “Define the nature of stuff by describing it”
- ◆ Browse/search by tag: conferences
- ◆ Add tags together: HCI+conferences

Example app: del.icio.us

- ◆ Pronounced: delicious
- ◆ Now owned by Yahoo (here to stay?)
- ◆ Free to use, ad supported search
- ◆ Slick interface, constant improvements, API
- ◆ We don't endorse it officially!
- ◆ But: our testbed for bigger HCI community project
- ◆ I (chris) have used it since Feb. 06
(now: 350 links, 260 tags)

Cool del.icio.us Stuff

(= ice-cream?):

- ◆ Create tag bundles multi_sensory = haptic, haptics, audio, sound, vision
- ◆ Easy tag entry (auto-complete your tags), recommended tag
- ◆ Sent links to peer (via for:kevint tag)
- ◆ Links have notes (paint before tag - auto-note)
- ◆ Filter link list: +, by username, by tag (!)
- ◆ Search tags (notes?) : my del., all of del.

◆ Interface:

- ◆ Link list (edit/del, # of others have tagged it)
- ◆ tag-cloud (maybe sorted by alphabet)
- ◆ Frequency-thresholds (unclutter your tags)
- ◆ Related tags (only for filters! - great for finding relationships!)
- ◆ See/hide bundles (cloud)

- ◆ tag networks (community setup)
- ◆ Subscribe to some tags from other de. users (called "inbox")
- ◆ RSS:
 - ◆ List of newest links for any del. page
 - ◆ need RSS reader in your browser
 - ◆ I like Sage (firefox), drag in RSS feed, detect RSS feed on pages
- ◆ Tagroll and link roll (for your webpage, blog)

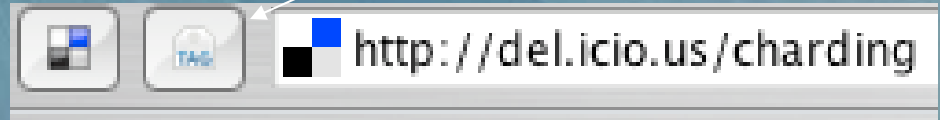
To protect your computer, Firefox prevented this site (del.icio.us) from installing software on your computer.
